

#### **Notice of Race**

## 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

# 2. LOCATION AND PROGRAM

Maccagno – Lago Maggiore – 28/30 July, 2012. The program of the event will be the following:

Friday July 27th, 6 PM: Opening Briefing at the UVM clubhouse.

Saturday July 28th, 10.30 AM: skipper meeting with the Race Officers at the launching area.

12.00 AM, warning signal first race

Sunday July 29th – racing Monday July 30th – racing

No warning signal will be given after 4.00 PM.

Nine races are scheduled, with a maximum of 3 races per day. Time of Warining signal for race of July 29th and 30thwill be communicated by the race officer on the previous day.

### 3. BOAT PARK AND LAUNCHING

The boat park and launching area will be at Parco Giona. All cars must be parked in the car parks within Parco Giona. A PASS will be given to competitors, allowing entry and parking in Parco Giona. All cars without a PASS must pay the entry and parking fee at the bar in Parco Giona. It is strictly forbidden to enter with cars in the boat park and launching area. Trailers must be hand-driven to enter the boat park-launching area

## 4. RULES

Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in ISAF 2009/2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and by the sailing instructions for the event. In case of any conflicts the Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race for the event will apply. For breaking a Rule in Part 2 of RRS, Rules 44.1 and 44.2(RRS) will apply, with the variation that the penalty will be a single turn (360°) including one tack and one gybe.

## 5. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to ISO and Buzz class only. All competitors need to have a valid insurance against third party claims to a sum of at least Euro 1,000,000. Italian Competitors must have a valid 2012 FIV subscription including health certificates. Foreign competitors must comply with the rules of their own National Authorities. All boats shall be registered with their respective Class Association for 2012. All relevant documents must be shown to the Organizing Authority at entry.

### 6. ENTRY

Entries must be received by the Organizing Club (either by email, FAX or post) by July 10th, 2012. Entry fee is 160 Euro. All entries must be completed showing the original documents (class association, insurance certificate and National Authority documents) to the Organizing Club before 1000hrs of July 28th, 2012. Only after payment of the entry fee and after completing the entry competitors will be formally entered into the event.

Entries received after July, 10th, 2012 can be accepted by the Organizing Club, for late entries the entry fee will be of 200 Euro.

The Secretary of UVM will be officially open for completing the entries on Friday, July 27th 2012 (1600-1800hrs) and Saturday, July 28th, 2012, form 0830hrs.

# 7. MEASUREMENTS

Rule 78.1 RRS will apply. No measurement controls will be performed before racing, but the Racing Committee or the Protest Committee may require measurement controls during the event.

## 8. SCORING & DISCARDS

The Low Point System will be used, as defined by Rule 90.3 RRS and Appendix A RRS. After 4 races have been completed, one will be excluded from the score of each boat. After 8 races have been completed, two will be excluded from the score of each boat. The series will be valid with any number of completed races.

## 9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for the first three boats of each class. Prize for the first female team of each class. All competitors will receive a *souvenir* of the event.

## 10. ADVERTISING

Regulation 20 ISAF must be followed. Advertising is free as per Class Rules.

### 11. RESPONSABILITY

As per Fundamental Rule 4 ISAF, Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety and for their decision to start or continue racing. Competitors take part in the event at their own risk and under their personal responsibility. The Organizing Club and the Race Committee will have no responsibility for damages suffered from people and/or boats as a consequence of participation to the event.

## 12. PHOTOGRAPHIC/TV RIGHTS

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

## 13. SOCIAL EVENTS

Friday, July 27th, 6 PM at the UVM clubhouse: Opening Briefing with food and drink.

Each day, after finishing the daily racing, at the clubhouse prizes will be awarded to the daily race winners with food and drink.

Monday, July 30th: Prize giving with food and drink.
